

The interior elements consist of 7 types, namely space, line, shape, light, color, texture, and pattern. - (a) Space. Space is one of the basic interior elements that must be considered in a design. Space consists of 2 types, namely 2-dimensional space and 3-dimensional space. In designing, a designer must know the exact size and utility of a room in order to adapt its design to a particular space. Spaces with Modern Luxury design concepts usually rarely use partitions so that the room seems spacious so that users can also move freely without a lot of items that maintain a modern impression;
- (b) Line. Generally, lines are divided into 3 types, namely horizontal lines, vertical lines, and diagonal lines. When designing a room, if the line elements are used appropriately, it will add to the aesthetics of a room. For example, curved lines or zigzags will show dynamic energy in a room. In the Modern Luxury design concept, line elements are usually used in the form of vertical lines combined with walls, as well as furniture used with the aim of a room not being boring, looking attractive, and giving a modern impression. In addition to the use of straight lines, the line elements in the modern luxury style can also be combined with other geometric shapes such as circles, hexagons, squares, and triangles. The use of these forms is intended so that the interior of a room is not boring and still looks attractive;

- (d) Light. Light is quite important in a room, be it artificial light or natural light because it can give an accent to a room. Light is divided into three types, namely lighting according to function

(task lighting), lighting for accents (accent lighting), and lighting to add to the atmosphere (mood lighting). When determining the lighting of a room, it is important for a designer to know the types of activities that will be carried out in the room. Like rooms can use bright to dim types of lighting. Rooms with the Modern Luxury concept can also use white and yellow lighting. In modern luxurious homes, the right lighting must be chosen for the perfect home interior design. Optionally for modern and simple chandeliers or drop pendants, then complete the look with cove and pin lights for a subtle yet dramatic feel, and to create an ambience by lighting up specific areas of your room. Note that warm lights are often used in the modern luxury interior design style to create a homely and sophisticated vibe;

(e) Color. Color is one element that can change the atmosphere in a room. Color can also change emotions and stimulate the psychology of the room's users. For example, green and blue colors will give the impression of a calm room, and red will encourage appetite so it is often used in restaurants. In Modern Luxury style rooms, the colors that are often used are neutral colors such as white, black, brown, gray, and beige [4]. Not infrequently Modern Luxury style rooms add accents with contrasting colors such as gold, silver, and several luxury colors such as red, and purple so that it will give the impression of a dynamic room, as well as modern accents. Conceptualising the best colour scheme for your modern luxury home interior design is simple; start by choosing three of your favourite modern colours, followed by two luxurious, the number of colours used can be tweaked around. The modern colours will be your home's base colour palette, while the luxurious colours will be used as an accent colour;

- (b) Space Circulation. Designing a modern luxury style room does not have to be a large room. Minimizing the use of partitions in the room can make the room look more spacious. In addition, the use of mirrors can also make the room look wider than the original;
- (c) Furniture. In the stage of selecting furniture for a modern luxury-style room, you can choose to use minimalist furniture so that it seems more simple, one of which is built-in furniture. because one of the advantages of built-in furniture is that it can save more expenses and can choose a more appropriate size for space capacity so that it can use the corners of the room more

optimally. In addition, the built in furniture can also be made more multifunctional for several activities at once;

(d) Technology. The word modern is often close to the word technology. Smart homes are currently very popular with the public, especially millennials, who are also fans of modern luxury styles. The existence of sophisticated technology at home will greatly help facilitate the fast-paced and efficient work of millennials.

4. CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The room is a private/private space, so the design in a room must be adapted to the characteristics and lifestyle habits of its users.
